- 1. List two reasons why God commanded Moses to build the Tabernacle.
- 2. Describe the measurements of the Outer Court and their spiritual significance.
- 3. Describe the spiritual significance of white linen from Scripture.
- 4. What does silver speak of in the Word of God? Explain your answer.
- 5. What is the spiritual significance of the colors of the door of the Tabernacle and what do they reveal about Christ?
- 6. Explain from the Tabernacle of Moses why Christ is the only way of salvation. Support with scripture.
- 7. The Israelites had to personally appropriate the blood of the Passover lamb in order to be saved. Explain the spiritual significance of this.
- 8. Many of the Israelites died in the wilderness journey because of disobedience. Explain the importance of walking in the light from 1 John 1:7.
- 9. How do we know that the Red Sea typifies water baptism and why is this important for believers?
- 10. How do we know that the baptism of the Holy Spirit is a subsequent experience to salvation?
- 11. There was one entrance into the Holy Place called the Door of the Tabernacle. Describe this hanging door.
- 12. The five pillars represent the five Levitical offerings. Briefly describe the spiritual interpretation of the five offerings.
- 13. The loaves of bread were sprinkled with frankincense, which speak of faith. Why was this so important?

- 14. The loaves of bread speak of us as believers becoming bread to feed the nations. Describe the natural process of breadmaking and how it relates to us spiritually becoming broken bread.
- 15. The Candlestick provided the only light in the Holy Place. Thus its primary function was to illuminate the Holy Place. It shined light upon the Golden Altar and the Table of Shewbread. What is the spiritual significance of this?
- 16. Prove from Scripture that incense speaks of prayer, praise, and worship.
- 17. The incense for the Golden Altar was made of stacte, onycha, galbanum, and frankincense. Describe each of these spices and their spiritual interpretation as they relate to prayer.
- 18. There was a veil hung upon four pillars that separated the Holy Place from the Holy of Holies. What spiritual experience does this veil speak of?
- 19. What is the New Covenant?
- 20. The purpose of God is for every Christian to progress within the veil into the Holy of Holies to become a spiritual father. Describe, in your own words, the ministry and character of a spiritual father.
